How to get there:

By plane: The airport Schwechat is located in the south-east of Vienna. Travel to the city center "Wien Mitte" using the rapid train railway S7 or the City Airport Train CAT. Take subway U4 (direction Heiligenstadt) to Spittelau and from there the bus 37A to Dänenstraße (final stop). Duration: 45-60 Minutes.

By train: If you reach Wien Meidling take the subway U6 (direction Floridsdorf) to Währingerstraße Volksoper. From there take the bus 40A (direction Döblinger Friedhof) to Dänenstraße. Duration: 30 Minutes.
