



BEST OF SOUTH-EAST SCHOLARHSIP PROGRAM 2021/2022

Best of South-East (BOSE) is a scholarship-program initiated by the Steiermärkische Sparkasse, in cooperation with **Montanuniversitaet Leoben (MUL)**, University of Graz, University of Music and Performing Arts Graz and TU Graz. It is a training and education program for talented and dedicated students from **Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Montenegro and North Macedonia.**

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 21 December 2020 (12pm CET)

The online application will close on that day!

The scholarship program lasts 12 months (from September to the end of August) and includes at Montanuniversitaet Leoben (MUL):

- A scholarship of <u>750€ monthly for an entire year</u> from September until August (sponsored by Steiermärkische Sparkasse)
- A tuition fee waiver for two semesters at Montanuniveristaet Leoben (winter and summer semester)
- A two weeks Intensive English course before the first semester starts
- A two month long trainee program or internship (self-organized) in July and August right after the end of the academic year

The program's aim is to provide scholarship-holders with **international education**, work experience and training opportunities. Scholarship-holders benefit greatly from the BOSE- program in multiple ways:

- → Academic added value from studying at MUL
- \rightarrow Career facilitation through an international internship
- \rightarrow Enhancement of your chances on the job market through studying and working abroad

During the scholarship program, **events** and **informative meetings** ensure that scholarship-holders are integrated into the economic, cultural and scientific life in Styria. On order to improve your language skills German and English language courses can be attended.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Citizenship: Slovenian, Bosnian and Herzegovinian, Croatian, Serbian, Montenegro or North Macedonia.
- The applicant must be enrolled as regular student at a foreign university or at MUL
- Language skills in English (minimum level B2) or German (minimum level B2)
- Students have to be at least in their third semesters of their Bachelor program at the time of the application
- Only applicants that are maximum 27 years old at the time of the application are accepted
- Master students who want to write their Master thesis or PhD students require a letter of confirmation of a supervisor at MUL (our office can help you to find a supervisor at MUL)
- Very good grades, motivation, commitment, good communication skills, adaptability, theoretical knowledge, as well as practical skills

→ Scholarship holders must complete min. 30 ECTS at MUL in the academic year (15 ECTS per semester)

APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1: Request the link to the online application platform at MIRO

Send an application request to <u>anja.zarfl@unileoben.ac.at</u> with the following information:

- First and last name (as in your passport)
- Date of birth (DD / MM / YYYY) (as in your passport)
- Citizenship (as in your passport)
- Name of your home university in both the native language and in English
- Name of your <u>current</u> academic program + your <u>current</u> study level (BSc, MSc, PhD)
- The academic program + the study level you want to apply for at MUL (examples: BSc mining and tunnelling / MSc petroleum engineering / PhD metallurgy)

You will receive a link to the online platform Mobility Online where you will have to complete your application.

You should do STEP 1 as soon as you know you want to apply, but at the latest <u>until the end of November!</u> This will leave you enough time to fill out your application on the online platform in due time!

Step 2: Apply on the Online Application Platform 'Mobility Online'

- Login data for the platform will be sent to you upon request (Step 1)
- Fill out all necessary data and upload all required documents : You will need the following documents to apply on our online platform:
 - Learning Agreement = course program to be completed at MUL-<u>only page 1, signatures not yet</u> <u>needed!</u> Search for courses at: <u>https://online.unileoben.ac.at/mu_online/studienplaene.studienrich-</u> <u>tungen?corg_nr=1&csprache_nr=2&csj_nr=&cmode=&pStatusTyp=N&pGrouping=A</u> You can always change the language (German or English) in the upper right corner. NOTE: You <u>are not allowed</u> to take courses that are part of a <u>'Universitätslehrgang</u> – by clicking on the name of the course you can see which type of course it is.
 - 2. **Confirmation of enrolment** from the applicant's home university
 - 3. **Motivation letter** in the form of an essay (maximum 2 pages!); the focus of the essay should be on the applicant's individual interests and motivation; why do you want to attend MUL?
 - 4. **Transcript of Records / Diploma Certificate** (if the original is in a language other than English or German, a translation in English or German certified by the home university is necessary):
 - For Master's students: Bachelor's degree certificate and transcript of records from the Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes
 - For PhD students: Bachelor's and Master's degree certificates, as well as the transcript of records from the Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral degree programmes
 - 5. **2 letters of recommendation**: Both letters of recommendation must be written by teachers who taught or supervised the applicant during his/her degree programme. One of the two letters of recommendation must be issued by an academic.









- 6. Curriculum vitae in tabular form (in English or German)
- 7. Copy of your passport
- 8. Proof of German or English language skills: Language certificates may not be older than one year.
 - German language skills (at least level B2); an official certificate is a bonus!
 - English language skills (at least level B2); an official certificate is a bonus! If you do not have an official certificate, you can have our 'language proficiency report' confirmed by a language centre or institute. → you can find the report in the download section on our application platform
