

Enrollment in the academic year 2026/2027:

Important information for students for completing the enrollment paper in ŠIS – [UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES](#) (in English)

Below are important information for students to review before they begin completing the enrollment paper in ŠIS (Student Information System UP). General information applicable to all study programmes is presented first, followed by programme-specific information for individual study programmes (offered in English). If a study programme is not listed, no special provisions apply.

The list of compulsory and elective courses 2026/2027 is available in ŠIS (Curriculum / Curriculum Implementation Plan) from 15 July 2026. Please note that changes of courses may also occur after publication. Any such changes will be entered into ŠIS as they arise.

If a student wishes to change an elective course selected during enrolment, they may notify the Student Services by email (referat@famnit.upr.si) no later than 30 September 2026, indicating both the previously selected elective course and the new one. The Student Affairs Office will record the change in the student's index.

General information

- ❖ The curriculum of the study programme is available on the faculty's website under the programme description.
- ❖ The study location shown is based on where the majority of the programme is conducted (Izola – Conservation Biology, Agronomy; Koper – other programmes). The exact location for each individual course will be specified in the timetable.
- ❖ It is in students' interests that the courses are evenly distributed throughout the entire academic year. Therefore, before choosing elective courses, check in which semester the courses will be implemented.
- ❖ Students may select an elective course offered for the year of study in which they are enrolling. Any exceptions must be approved in advance by the programme coordinator. After submitting the enrolment paper in ŠIS, students must send the programme coordinator's written approval to the Student Services by email.
- ❖ If a student selects an elective course from another programme as an internal elective within their enrolled programme, the course must be accredited as an internal elective for that programme. The list of internal elective courses is available on the faculty's website under the programme description.
- ❖ When selecting external elective courses from outside their enrolled programme, students must check any content-related restrictions that the respective programme applies to external electives. These restrictions are available on the faculty's website under the programme description.
- ❖ Students are advised that if they choose an elective course that is not included in the list of courses offered for their enrolled programme and year of study, the timetable for that course will be arranged according to the students for whom the course is primarily offered. Consequently, if scheduling conflicts arise, students will be responsible for making individual arrangements with the professor.

- ❖ Electiveness at the UP: in accordance with the content-related restrictions governing external electives for their enrolled programme (available on the faculty's website under the programme description), students may also choose courses offered by other members of the UP. In the enrolment paper in ŠIS, students should select "External Elective – within another study programme" and, at the same time, submit the application form. BIOINFORMATICS – in English

- ❖ The students of the 2nd year listen to the compulsory course of the 3rd year Physical Chemistry with Chemoinformatics, instead of choosing an elective course for the 2nd year. They will choose this elective course in the 3rd year in 2027/2028.

COMPUTER SCIENCES – in English

- ❖ The first external elective course in the 2nd year is the English language course. The student may substitute this course with any course that falls within the areas of Mathematics or Computer Science and is taught in English.
- ❖ From the academic year 2026/2027 students of the 3rd year of study will attend a new compulsory course Statistics instead of 1 external elective course.

MATHEMATICS – in English

- ❖ Internal elective courses of the 2nd and 3rd year must include at least 5 mathematical courses.
- ❖ On completing the 2nd year, students can opt for a study field. In the academic year 2026/2027 only General Mathematics is available. More information about study fields can be found on the faculty's website under the programme description.
