My career opportunities

Graduates may pursue careers in:

- The full range of positions in the public sector where psychologists are employed, particularly in healthcare, education (subject to meeting additional requirements, such as completing teacher education and adult education training), social services, the justice system, defence, and related fields
- Non-governmental and non-profit organizations, working in areas such as psychological prevention, rehabilitation, supportive therapy, and psychosocial care
- The private sector, including psychotherapy, psychological counselling, and related services
- Companies and organizations in human resources, marketing, public relations, organizational development, coaching, psychological consulting, and team development

In addition to these career paths, graduates are also well prepared for positions that are not exclusively psychology-related but require a broad social sciences background, such as roles in public policy, the media, research, public administration, and other related fields.
