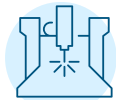

- In other industrial sectors (e.g. biotechnology), provided they acquire the relevant additional knowledge and skills through elective courses.

Graduates may also engage in research and development activities in a variety of institutions or pursue independent scientific research at research organizations.
